<p><b>18 November, 2023</b> <i>Probation period reduced</i></p>	<p>The terms of probation period for newly-hired employees are amended as follows:</p> <p><i>Article 51.1. Except for the cases specified in Article 52 of this Code, the employment contract may be concluded by determining the probationary period in order to check the level of professionalism of the employee and the ability to perform the relevant labour function.
